



To Our Valued Customers:

Coweta County Water and Sewerage Authority is developing a program to help improve the management of our water distribution system and the quality of services that we provide to you. This program will produce a computerized hydraulic model of our entire water distribution system, and it will permit us to optimize operations, identify where system improvements may be needed, and to analyze various potential improvement options.

Over the next several months, we will be conducting tests on the water system to collect data that will be used to construct the hydraulic model. These tests may temporarily affect the water supply to localized areas around the system. You may also notice our employees on the road as they conduct fire flow tests within the right-of-way.

We request your patience with our progress over the next several months. During this time, you may experience temporary issues with water flow and pressure, cloudiness in your tap water, and minor delay on the roadways. Our team is developing a plan that will minimize these occurrences to the greatest possible extent and that will ensure reliable service to mission-critical operations such as hospitals and fire services.
